



From July 3rd till July 31st 2016, UNTILTHEN is delighted to present the personal project of the French artist Bady Dalloul in the space **NOW&THEN**.

Bady Dalloul presents no title, 2016 a series of 120 sketches drawn with ballpoint pen, felt tip pen and colour crayons. These small childlike sketches (4,5 x 2,2cm) depict the Syrian civil war which started in 2011. The sketches are individually framed in small matchbox drawers that form an interrupted timeline of events to emphasise the memory of more persistent images.

The origin of the piece can be traced back to the artist's stamp collection which he had as a boy, it was while observing blank stamps that his mind would fill them with images of his own. In Bady Dalloul's sketches today he shows the multifaceted and extremely diverse situations in which the conflict in Syria takes place by depicting scenes of manifestations, collective prayer, street life and homes.

The omnipresent cars, flags and armed civilians in their homes assembling molotov cocktails give us insight into the day to day life of this merciless war. The violence is felt in every drawing and seems to be amplified in the ones depicting battered and demolished buildings or scenes showing abandoned corpses. It is also reinforced by the small size of the drawings which are conveniently placed at eye height and hold our attention as the concentration of different signs and colour seem to almost explode off the paper.

With this strange collection of memories that show a country ravaged by war (which one could feel inclined to collect) - Bady Dalloul, a worried observer of his country of origin, seems to remind us that Syria exists and has become what he calls 'a country without a door or a window'.
